Extract from Capitular law on qualifications of candidate:

Sec. 224. Qualification of Candidates. Every candidate applying for the degrees of Capitular Masonry must:

(1) Be a Master Mason in good standing in some regular lodge of Master Masons.

(2) Have resided within the jurisdiction of this Grand Chapter for one year and within the jurisdiction of the constituent Chapter for three months preceding the presentation of the petition; providing that where the petitioner has not resided within the jurisdiction of the constituent Chapter for one year preceding the presentation of his petition, a report on such petition should be secured from the Chapter having jurisdiction over the territory of his former residence, and provided further that a person in the service of the United States Government not qualified by residence for one year, may present his petition if the Grand High Priest grants a dispensation to the Chapter to receive and consider it.

(3) Not have been rejected by any Chapter during the six months immediately preceding the presentation of his petition, or as provided in Section 106 (14).

Sec. 225. (1) No petition for the degrees of Capitular Masonry shall be received or considered by any Chapter if the applicant has been previously rejected by a Chapter of Royal Arch Masons, without the consent of the Chapter which rejected the applicant, subject to Section 206.
